Remote Learning Information for Parents

Children and families working remotely, from home, will be provided with the following:

- A planned and well sequenced curriculum that closely matches the curriculum outlined in the medium term plans for all year groups - as available on the curriculum pages of our website.
- Access to high quality online and offline resources, including some teaching videos, which are closely linked to our school's curriculum. This will be accessed via weekly plans which are displayed on our school website. The teaching videos being used to support remote learning will be provided through The Oaks National Academy, BBC Bitesize, CBBC, and White Rose Maths.
- Regular interaction, through Seesaw, to provide feedback and assessment opportunities.
- Work packs and resources provided weekly which can be dropped off and collected from the school office each Friday, for children who are having difficulty using online learning platforms or who prefer to work offline.
- Regular communication from our school SENDco for any children needing SEN support.
- English and Maths work daily, along with different foundation subjects to enable full coverage.
- Communication from school regarding their child's remote learning and wellbeing, along with information on how to seek advice or support if needed.
- Digital facilities, currently we are organising, further digital facilities, to enable whole class interaction and feedback with their class teacher. We will be sending out consent forms, procedures and protocols in order to facilitate this, next week. Parents wanting their child to participate in this will then be sent more details and access information.

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
