First Day – Thursday 2nd September




On your child's first day, they will be staying for a shorter session. They should come to school in their uniform and will be greeted by their class teacher at the door.

The children will stay for 2 hours and have a chance to meet and make friends, explore the environment and get to know the staff.

When you collect your child there will be a chance to chat with staff and see how the first day has gone.

If your child is a bit nervous it is a good idea to bring along a teddy or a favourite toy on this first day to keep them company.





A day in the life of Reception Class

- Your child should arrive at the classroom door between 8:40 and 9am
- Children will have registration, carpet time and then move into continuous provision. The children can access learning indoors and outdoors through play activities and some adult led activities.
- Snack, for a voluntary contribution of £1 a week or you can pay for the half term, children will have snack provided each day.
- Lunch time – The children may bring their own packed lunch or have a school dinner for all children in Reception class school lunches are free. Menu is available on the website.
- Children will continue to learn through play in the afternoon, followed by story and singing time.
- Children can be collected from the classroom door at 3:10pm





Our School Uniform



Information about our school uniform is available on our school website, there will also be information about suppliers you can use if you want to purchase items with our school logo in the information pack you will be receiving following this meeting.

You can choose between grey trouser, shorts, skirt or pinafore with a yellow polo shirt

Our school jumpers or cardigans are red, these can be purchased with or without school logo.

When the weather is warmer between April and October the children can choose to wear red and white summer dresses, shorts and a white polo shirt.





Early Reading




Early reading is a big focus in our Reception class, the children will have many opportunities to explore, experience and develop the love of learning.

We use Read Write inc. phonics scheme throughout our school, there is more information on our school website about this and information will be sent out through out the year. We will also be holding information meetings for parents to support you and your child with their phonics development throughout the year.

Oxford Reading Tree – The children will bring their first book home to share with you after they have settled into school. **We will be providing** (free of charge) a **Knowsley Village School Reading bag** to all of our Reception children and this bag should be brought to school each day.

Book Corners and Story Time – We will be reading lots of stories to your child we will share with you the stories we are reading and we would also love for you to let us know any books your child loves reading with you at home too.





P.E. Days



Reception class have PE each Tuesday

On this day the children should come to school wearing their PE clothes. They can wear a school t-shirt or red t-shirt, black shorts and black pumps. Or if you prefer your child can come in a tracksuit or other sports clothes with a pair of trainers.

This year we have found it is much better for the children to wear their kits all day as it allows more time to do PE, with less time being spent getting changed and certainly less clothes being lost or swapped!



Early Learning



The children will have access to our indoor and outdoor classrooms during continuous provision. They can choose either room and the activities and learning available will be closely matched to your child's learning styles and ability. We follow the EYFS curriculum and the children have access to paint, water, sand, construction, bikes, mud kitchen, role play areas. There is also a

- maths and mark making area in each room, along with an investigation table.

Lots to keep the children very busy and excited every day.



Behaviour and Attendance

- In Reception class and throughout the school we use the language of choice to support the children with their behaviour choices.
- The children are encouraged to make the right or good choice be praised. Our children respond very well to this way of developing their independence and social skills.
- If children make a wrong choice they are supported by staff to look at how they could have made a better choice and encouraged to make that better choice next time.
- Mrs. Barlow will hold a meeting for parents to give more information for supporting your child with their choices later in the Autumn Term.
- If your child is unwell or absent for the day please send a ParentApp, email or phone call to school with a reason for their absence.



Information Packs

- You will shortly receive a pack which includes lots of information, there is also an All About Me booklet for you to complete with your child, this will give Mrs. Abrams your child's class teacher more information about your child before they start school.
- ParentApp registration form – This is an App which allows school to communicate with you and you can send messages if your child is off sick or to make any payments which may be needed.
- Registration form – This is a very useful form as it includes important contact numbers and information about your child.
- Medical form- Again this is an important way to share information about your child with us.


