

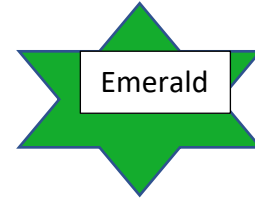
Robinwood

Class Curriculum Information

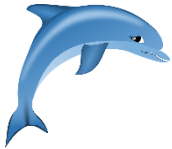

This week in Y1 Dolphin Class the children have began a History project called 'Childhood', learning about the passage of time. In Maths they have been sorting and counting objects.
