

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## **Class Curriculum Information**

Nursery Turtles held their first 'Stay and Play' session of the year. The children were very excited to show their parents and grandparents all the different areas in the room. The favourite areas to play were the home corner, construction area and creative area.



Reception Penguins have had a busy week beginning our phonics lessons! They have been so enthusiastic and ready to start their reading journey. We are very proud of the start they have made. We had a lovely 'Stay and Play' session with our grown-ups, where we shared messy play, creative and maths activities with parents and family members.



Year 1 Dolphins have been learning about the different stages of human life this week. In Maths they have been using <, > and = signs to compare numbers within 10. In Art they have been identifying similarities and differences between two or more pieces of artwork. The children have continued to practice their phonics with Fred.



This week, Year 2 Pandas have learned about the four compass points North, East, South and West. They then looked at the map of the UK and described the direction of the countries and cities using these compass points.



This week in Year 3 Leopards we started our new maths topic of Addition and Subtraction. The children have all worked hard to use their knowledge of number bonds to add and subtract numbers to 100! In our English lessons we have been focusing on using inverted commas to identify speech.



Year 4 Jaguars have had a great week learning about electrical conductors and insulators. We made our own home-made switches! We have learned about Roman Numerals too this week and have had the CLC in to work on Coding with us.



Year 5 Tigers have shown fantastic growth mindset this week while tackling some tricky rounding in Maths. Ms Rowe is super proud of their resilience and perseverance.



In Year 6 Lions this week we have been learning about the functions of the human heart, in science we investigated the different parts of the heart and how they all work together to help move the blood around the body. We have also developed our hockey skills in P.E., learning how to accurately pass the ball and played a mini game.
