

This week Nursery Turtles have been thinking about 'People Who Help Us'. The children enjoyed learning about different jobs that people can do. We also looked at different types of vehicles and made some super pictures using 2D shapes.



This week Reception Penguins have been celebrating World Space Week! We have been thinking about what we would take to space with us, like Baby Bear in 'Whatever Next.' We have been doing space themed artwork and building rockets! In our music lesson, we have learnt the names of some percussion instruments and have been playing them to a beat.



This week Year 1 Dolphins have identified significant stages in a lifetime and recalled special events. In Science they have identified similarities and differences between themselves and others. In Art they have explored colour mixing and printing.



This week Year 2 Pandas have learned about the great explorer Christopher Columbus. They discovered his early life and the impact he made on exploration.



In Year 3 Leopards this week we have enjoyed creating our own portraits inspired by the work of Vincent Van Gogh. In Science this week we were able to accurately identify and label some of the bones in the human skeleton.



Year 4 Jaguars have had a great week and have been using digital technology to build their own circuits on iPads. In Geography we are beginning to learn about tropical climates.



This week Year 5 Tigers have been writing about the Northern Lights and imagining what it would be like to ride a dog sled to the North Pole, like Matt in their class novel, 'Race to the Frozen North.' They have been learning about climate zones in Geography and rocking out to 'Livin' on a Prayer' their Charanga Music School song for this half term!
