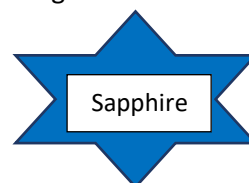

Class Curriculum Information

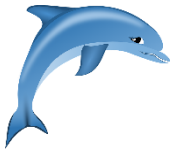
