This week Nursery Turtles have enjoyed talking about their own holiday photographs with their friends. We have looked at different animals and the different habitats where they live, for example, jungle, sea, arctic, etc. The children have been working hard tracing and following patterns.



This week Reception Penguins have continued to enjoy the story 'Supertato'. This week we have focused on the character 'evil pea'. The children drew some wonderful pictures and wrote words and sentences to describe him. In maths we have been working on addition and number bonds to 10.



We have had a wonderful week of learning in Year 1 Dolphins. The children have identified the main characters from 'A Midsummer Nights Dream' and identified their feelings and emotions. IN Maths they have been identifying missing numbers on a timeline between 50 and 100. In RE they have been learning about the importance of Puja to Hindus. In Science they have been introduced to a new topic about materials. Today in Design Technology they have designed and created their own summer salad.



This week Year 2 Pandas have continued reading 'The Tempest' by Rosie Dickins. The children learned about the different weather conditions that make a storm and have written some fabulous descriptions. Also this week, the children have been learning to tell the time which they are very good at and in DT they have explored chopping different vegetables.



This week in Year 3 Leopards we have enjoyed creating our own play scripts and acting these out inspired by our class book 'The Merchant of Venice'. We have also been working very hard in maths this week identifying parallel and perpendicular lines before drawing our own polygons using a range of edges, vertices and angles! We are all really looking forward to our school trip next week to Blackpool Zoo!
