### Reception Penguins Graduation

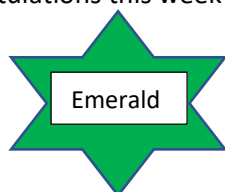

### Class Curriculum Information

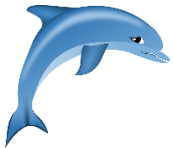

We have had a fantastic week in Year 1 Dolphins. In Science the children have been identifying properties of materials. In Maths they have been learning how to tell the time to the hour and half hour. In Phonics the children have continued to practice reading longer words and read in their colour groups. The children were delighted to perform their songs on our school stage which they have been learning in our Music Workshops (I have shared via Seesaw).



Year 2 Pandas have had a wonderful week! They have finished their English book, *The Tempest*, and written a fabulous retelling from the perspective of the narrator. In maths, they have been solving mystery reasoning questions, applying their problem-solving skills in creative ways. In science, they completed their learning on animal survival by designing their own microhabitats, making sure each one included everything needed to survive — air, shelter, water, food, and sunlight.



This week in Year 3 Leopards the children have enjoyed finishing our topic of Emperors and Empires by researching the withdrawal of the Romans from Britain and the arrival of the Anglo-Saxons. During our science lesson this week the children completed an assessment on light and shadow, well done for all your hard work. We're all looking forward to our final week together in Year 3, with lots of exciting activities still to come!



Year 4 Jaguars have enjoyed their work in Art and DT this week. We have made Clay Bakugan horses, Islamic tiles, and in DT we made mechanisms to help the Egyptians to build the pyramids. A creative week! We also had a visit from the CLC to create a reading blog.
