This week Reception Penguins have focussed on the following sounds during RWInc Phonics session - u, b, g, v and w. The children are working hard when forming letters correctly. In maths we have been practicing counting from 1-20. The children have been identifying how many objects are in each set. We have shared the story 'Cinderella'. We have enjoyed planning our own fantasy story based on our class book Winters Child. In our maths lessons we have been finishing our topic of multiplication and division. Well done everyone!
