

We have had an exciting week of learning in Year 1 Dolphins. In Geography they have been discovering features of a city. Everyone looked amazing for Number Day today. We completed lots of number challenges including a number hunt, finding missing numbers on a number line and working with money in our Pudding Lane Bakery.

We have continued our English work around the book The Dragon Machine, and the children have written some fabulous leaflets on how to care for a dragon, including different sentence types.
